Climb The Ladder With Our Medical Assistant Apprenticeship Program



This program supports candidates who are new to the field of Medical Assisting to apply to train and work as a Medical Assistant at NorthLakes Community Clinic as part of our MA Apprenticeship program.

Becoming a Certified Medical Assistant (CMA) allows you to learn and earn more, and it's free to you. NorthLakes covers the cost of the program, the course, and the certification.

What You'll Do:

As a Medical Assistant, you'll engage with patients and providers to deliver whole-person care. This includes promoting preventative care, assisting patients with treatment plans, and helping patients remove barriers that may prevent them from gaining access to care.

Program Requirements:

- Acceptance into the program.
- Actively working towards ICATAP (In-Clinic Assistant Training Apprenticeship Program) completion while fulfilling your fulltime Medical Assistant scheduled work hours.
- Completing the educational coursework of the program outside of work hours. All coursework is to be completed within 12 months of program commencement.
- Complete the program's on-the-job skills requirements under the direction of the receptor.
- Obtain Medical Assistant certification within 12 months of obtaining the educational program.
- Commit to 12 months of employment with us in the role of a Certified Medical Assistant, following program completion and certification through American Medical Technologists (AMT) or National Healthcareer Association (NHA).
